

# How to Download Video to Your Computer

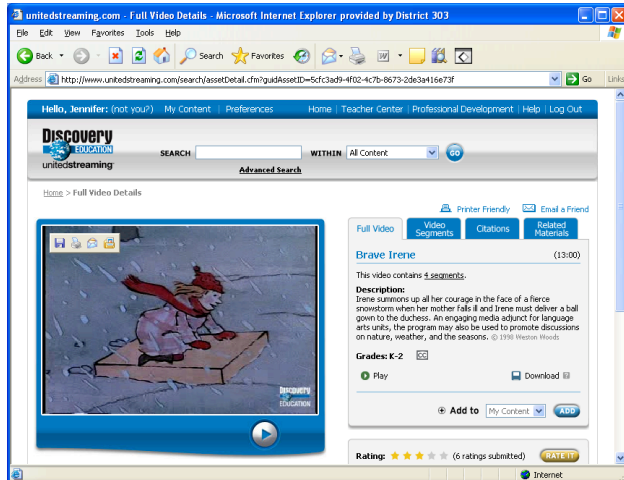
You may want to download the video so that it becomes a permanent file on your computer. In that way, you will not need to be connected to the Internet in order to view the video – a great idea if you are relying on viewing a video for your lesson.

## Step 1

From the “Full Video” screen, click on Download.

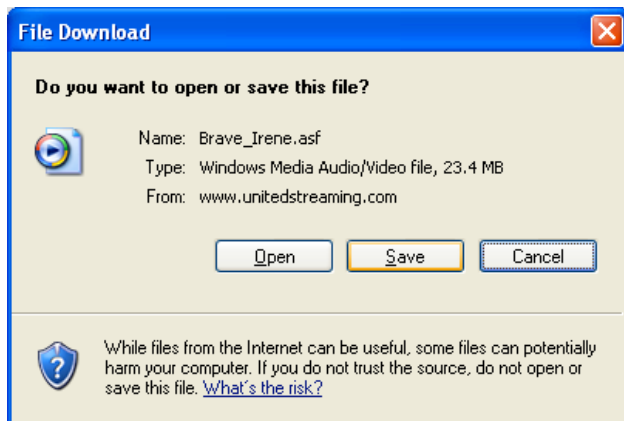
OR

From the “Video Segments” screen, click on the download icon (blue disk) next to the segment you wish to download.



## Step 2

Click on Save.

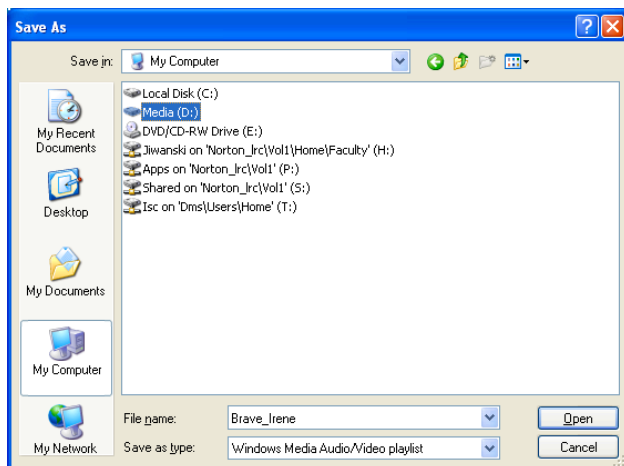


## Step 3

Save to the D: drive.

- Click on My Computer.
- Click once on Media (D:)
- Click once on Open.
- Once in the D: drive, you can create a name for your file and/or create a file to organize your videos in.
- Then click Save.

It will take the computer several minutes to download your file. When it is done, click Close.



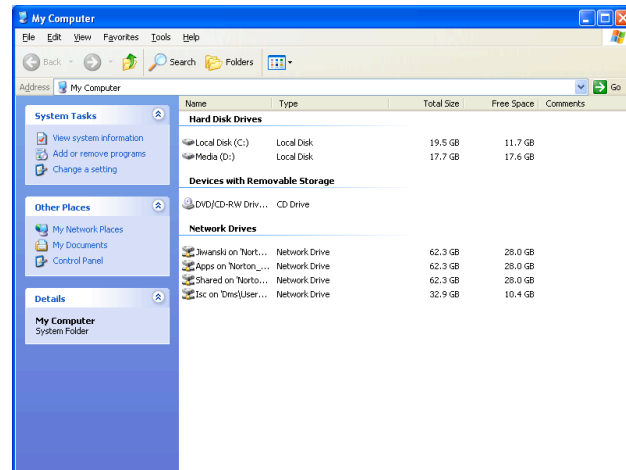
## How to Open a Downloaded File

### Step 1

From your desktop, click on My Computer.

### Step 2

Double click on Media (D:). Navigate to the folder your file is located in. Then double-click the name of the file and the video will automatically open in a new window and begin to play.



**Please note:** Video files are VERY large. Once you have used the video, I recommend you erase the file (drag to the Recycle Bin and empty the bin). Otherwise, your computer will become loaded down with unnecessary files which will negatively impact its performance.
